CALL MEETING TO ORDER: Dr. Zumwalt, Chairman called the Iroquois County Public Health Department Board of Health Finance Committee meeting to order at 1:08 PM on Friday, February 4, 2022, in the Iroquois County Board Room. Roll call was taken.

REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF CLAIMS FOR JANUARY 2022: A claims listing for January 2022 was distributed for review and approval. Discussion was held regarding January 2022 Claims. OLD BUSINESS:

NEW BUSINESS: A copy of the ICPHD grants and contracts list along with a summary report of programs through November 2021 was distributed for review. Mrs. Schippert informed committee members that she had applied for the COVID-19 Response Grant, which will replace the COVID-19 Contact Tracing Grant. The committee discussed COVID-19 mitigation and response. Mrs. Schippert stated that retention pay was approved in the COVID-19 Crisis Grant, further discussion on the topic will be held at the next full Board of Health meeting. Discussion was held regarding ICPHD reportable programs and ICPHD immunizations. Mrs. Schippert informed the board of new legislation involving farmer's markets and control of fees set by the local health department for inspections. Mrs. Schippert has been working with several local and state-level officials to represent local health departments' interests in the proposed legislation. Discussion was held. Per the purposed bill, the Board of Health may be required to hold a public hearing to discuss farmer's market inspection fees.

ADJOURNMENT: Mrs. Breymeyer made a motion, seconded by Dr. Zumwalt, to adjourn at 2:01 PM on Friday, February 4, 2022. Motion approved by unanimous voice vote.
